At a glance...

- 1 night Tena Tena Full board basis & game activities
- 2 nights Luangwa Bush Camps Full board basis & game activities
- 1 night Nsefu Camp Full board basis & game activities

Day 1: Mfuwe - Tena Tena

Arrive at the Mfuwe International Airport where you will be met, and transfer by road through villages and into the South Luangwa National Park to Tena Tena. (1hr15mins by road)

Situated in the exclusive Nsefu Sector, Tena Tena sits nestled under a magnificent and thick grove of mahogany trees. The six tents are very private with plenty of space between them and each has its own window onto a magnificent stretch of the Luangwa River where the hippos wallow and the lions roam. The en-suite bathrooms are spacious and open to the elements. Designed to copy nature they have curved walls around the trees, simple subtle colours and appealing views. Each tent is specifically located to maximize privacy both in the rooms, bathrooms and on the verandahs with comfortable sitting areas and excellent views onto the river.







This afternoon, take a game drive, returning for dinner.

Overnight Tena Tena, on a full board basis, with game experiences.

Day 2: Tena Tena – Luangwa Bush Camp



Rise with the sun and depart on your morning walk to your bush camp, situated in the Nsefu sector. Passionate and knowledgeable, your guide will impart bush insights as you go. (You may spend both nights at the same camp, depending on game movements.)

The camp is simple: Meru tents are stand-up and equipped with a bedroll, pillow, sheets and blankets. Ablutions are wash basins, a shared bucket shower and long-drop, bush loo. **Arrive into camp in time for a leisurely lunch and siesta.**

After tea depart on an afternoon walk returning to your camp for sundowners and dinner around the camp fire.

Distance: approx. 6 kms per walk

(Morning: Point to point route Afternoon: Walk out & return to camp)

Duration: approx. 3 hrs per walk

Overnight Luangwa Bush Camp, on a full board basis, including walking safaris.

Day 3: Luangwa Bush Camp

Over an early morning cup of coffee your guide will discuss plans for the day. Set off on foot, exploring the game rich Luangwa riverine area, with its ebony groves and lagoons.

Whilst you are out, the camp <u>may</u> move to a second site. This is entirely up to the guide and dependent on game movements.

Lunch at your camp, or enjoy an en-route picnic. Your afternoon walk is followed by sundowners and dinner under starstudded skies.

Distance: approx. 6 kms per walk (Point to point walk)

Duration: approx. 3 hrs per walk

Overnight Luangwa Bush Camp, on a full board basis, including walking safaris.

Day 4: Luangwa Bush Camp - Nsefu

After a leisurely breakfast, set off on foot. Break for tea and cake and arrive at Nsefu in time for lunch.

Situated far in the north of the exclusive Nsefu sector in the South Luangwa National Park, is one of the historic camps of Zambia, Nsefu. Sited on a sweeping bend of the Luangwa River, Nsefu has superb river views and overlooks a productive waterhole in this outstanding game-viewing area.

Nsefu accommodates 12 guests in 6 traditional thatch roof rondavals, one double and five twins. The rondavals have been beautifully restored, are whitewashed with a nostalgic vibe. Each rondaval has a clear view of the river through large

windows from the comfort of your bed or the chairs out on the wooden verandah. There are spacious, semi-open air ensuite facilities with a basin and shower and beds are draped with mosquito nets. The bar and sitting area sit snugly between a large termite mound and lagoon, making the most of the extensive wildlife that comes to the lagoon to drink. Thatched central spaces enjoy panoramic river views. The camp is run on solar power along with a back-up generator for cloudy days. Activities at Nsefu include day and night game drives, walking safaris, seasonal boating (end December to April), village/cultural tours and Tribal Textiles for locally produced hand-painted textiles.







Afternoon game drive and dinner at Nsefu.

Distance: approx. 6 kms per walk (Point to point walk)

Duration: approx. 3 hrs per walk

Overnight Nsefu Bush Lodge, on a full board basis, including game experiences.

Day 5: Nsefu - Depart

After an early morning game drive followed by breakfast, transfer to Mfuwe Airport.
