Nomad's Western Schedule

How it works...

Who can use the schedule?

Our western schedule is subsidised to make our camps more accessible and therefore can only be used by guests staying at Chada Katavi and/or Greystoke Mahale.

What days does it operate?

We operate a shared charter service between Arusha and Western Tanzania every **Monday and Thursday** (except 15 Mar to 31 May).

Camp arrivals and departures must therefore also fall on either a Monday or Thursday otherwise we regretfully have to pass on the price of the unused bednights that occur in **each Mon-Thurs or Thurs-Mon period**. While possible to arrive/depart by private charter, the most economical way is to stick to the schedule.

Which plane will be used?

Flights are shared and usually in a Cessna Caravan.

What are the route & timings?

(follow the route on the map)

1. Departs Arusha at 0800hrs
2. Pick up clients from the Serengeti if required (normally the closest airstrips to Lamai & Serengeti Safari Camp)
3. Via Tabora (for refuelling & toilet stop)
4. Drop-off/pick-up at Katavi 1215-1240hrs
5. Drop-off/pick-up at Mahale 1315-1340hrs
6. Via Tabora (for refuelling & toilet stop)
7. Possible drop off Serengeti if pre-booked (normally the closest airstrips to Lamai & Serengeti Safari Camp)
8. Arrives Arusha at around 1800hrs (with a possible Kilimanjaro drop off en route).

Lunch on arrival/departure days?

Westbound clients arrive in time for lunch in camp (Chada) or on the boat transfer (Greystoke) and eastbound clients depart with a picnic lunch box.

You can link up the West with the South & Coast using Safari Airlink's schedule flight, which we can book for you.

How to combine W.Tanzania with the south or Dar/Zanzibar?

Mahale/Katavi - Ruaha/Selous - Dar/Zanzibar

- Twice weekly flights from Mahale or Katavi to Selous/Ruaha/Dar/Zanzibar
- The flights operate on Mondays and Thursdays
- These schedule flights are operated by Safari Airlink on inducement - minimum of 2 pax
- The flight is a long day: departs Mahale at 1015hrs, via Katavi/Ruaha and lands in Selous at 1540hrs and on to Dar (1635hrs) and Zanzibar (1700hrs).

Dar/Zanzibar - Selous - Katavi/Mahale

- To get from Dar/Zanzibar or Selous to Mahale or Katavi, you need to overnight in Ruaha en-route.

Ruaha - Katavi / Mahale

- Safari Airlink flights operate twice a week on a Monday and Thursday
- The flight departs at 0700hrs from Ruaha, gets into Katavi at 0910hrs and into Mahale at 1000hrs.
